

  - Strains, concussions, lacerations



## **Round Table:**

Mark (Snow School) - Jan mtg

- Risk Management Info
- Straight lining sluice to lodge long speed runs
  - o Dave will be looking more at the Day lodge area merge with Patrol
  - o Action: Instructors to manage their "stopping areas"
  - Action: Ian, Dave & Tyler to potentially connect for a monthly chat regarding Risks seen around the area.
- Request to have yellow colored stripping added to Stairs at entrances better visibility.
  - **Action**: Stairs are to building code and do not require anything else at present. This would be above and beyond. Char to move to corrective action log for further discussion during summer projects.
- Racecourse
  - Action: Dave to f/u regarding Bob Swan Race course hazard marking

Tyler (Patrol)

- Some staff felt nauseated after ordering the staff meal for the day glory bowl.
- Mitigated immediately when BOH knew suspected it was the rice and thrown out immediately.

- Action: Char to f/u with BOH/Pete to understand if any food safe processes need to change.
- Patrol is low hand/feet warmers
  - Action: Buy some in town and add to budget for next season.

## Nick (BOH)

- Low boy (short stove) handle gets super-hot
  - Parts ordered
  - o Action: Parts have been ordered, when they arrive, they will be installed.
- Eye wash station
  - $_{\odot}$  Supplies were low and placed in an awkward location dealt with the next day
  - Action: Mitch to confirm checking eyewash station

# Lewis (OGS)

- Low stock of hand/feet warmers
- Action: Add to Dept budget to purchase at beginning of season
- Action: Chat with Mgr's if out, can purchase them in town.

Mikey (Glory/HBL)

- Icicles downstairs freezer, overhead hazard
  - Large icicles build up, low exit areas, could fall and hurt someone
  - Action: Dave to connect with TC for an "overhead Hazard" signage to use when required. This is usually dealt with very promptly
- Gutters on Glory
  - Not sealed properly needs to be Mitigating by sanding and knocking down icicles
  - Action: Lewis to f/u with OGS staff. When knocking down the icicles, be aware of the direction as some hit the window.
  - Action: Dave to look at gutter replacement for Glory this summer.

Nate (rentals)

- Overhead Light in snowboard area
  - Action: Dave adds it to basecamp for Jim- Updated- This is completed as of Feb 12 2025.

# James (IGS)

• Nothing to bring forward

# Bridie (FOH & Retail)

• Food item served which caused staff nausea. Rice- immediately mitigated.

- FOH/Bakers specific tongs to be used in the baking area when baked goods are put on plates. Need to make sure the separation of allergies exists. Ie: baked goods with nuts
  - Action: Nick & Bridie to resolve with Supv.

## Elspeth (Lifts)

- Guards on Top & bottom for Raven Chair heaters
  - Action: Dave to complete asap- added to Jim Js list.

## Dave (Mgmt)

• General reminder to staff to wash hands, stay home if sick, understand the threshold – mask for fellow co-workers.
