- Near Miss/Incident Reporting:
 - o Staff avalanche
- First aid statistics / summary (Dec 1-31)
 - o Strain (Some Repetitive), ankles, lower back, knees, shoulders
 - Investigations are ongoing.
 - Administration Control: changes to operational processes, work schedules
 - Supporting staff in understanding the difference between muscle aches while becoming used to body movements of the position and injury points.
 - Industry trends are up for both summer & winter.
 - Concussion worker flipping chairs at end of day on Summit, slipped on ice, chair swung and struck worker.
 - Worker on gradual return to work (GRTW)



 - Using the Blue dye is unfortunately not the solution at this point. It wears off in
