 - Line work classification – Med, High
 - # of workers
 - Look into First Reg.
- Discussion: Response plan in place does meet First Aid Requirements and staff are trained to respond.
- **Action:** Dave could go over the site safety plan
- **Action:** JC to follow-up with crew with above conversation and get back to JHSC committee.
 - Level 1 - kits still going with crews? Yes

- Green sea can - shelf unsecure, ready to fall over.
- **Action:** JC will F/U with Aidan - see if this is secure or removed. “Everyone knew” culture needs to be shifted. Tag the hazard with orange tape or a sign so everyone knows while being resolved.
